Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

I hope this message finds you well.

In his letter announcing the Jubilee Year 2025, Pope Francis begins with the inspiring words from St. Paul's letter to the Romans. "Hope does not disappoint" (Romans 5:5). This Hope, he continues, "is born in love and based on the love springing from the pierced heart of Jesus upon the cross." Over the course of this year of hope, we are invited to embark on a journey. A journey that takes us deeper into the Christian life as pilgrims. *Pilgrims of Hope*.

As Pilgrims of Hope, the Holy Father reminds us that, "pilgrimage is of course a fundamental element of every Jubilee event. Setting out on a journey is traditionally associated with our human quest for meaning in life."

During this Jubilee year there are many opportunities to participate in Jubilee events both at the Vatican and here in our own diocese. In addition to the resources and pilgrim locations, here at the Shrine of Saint Therese our Eucharistic Revival Team is inviting us on a spiritual "pilgrimage" as we read and discuss <u>33 Days to Eucharistic Glory</u>.

This journey began on Friday, January 31st and our first gathering to discuss and pray before the Blessed Sacrament will be on Tuesday, February 11 at 5:00pm in the Hospitality Room. If you would like to participate there's still time just give the office a call or sign up in the cloister.

As we walk through this inspiring book, completing the 33 Day journey with a consecration to the Eucharist on the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday or Shrove Tuesday, let us ask the Holy Spirit to inspire in us a deeper love for Christ who is our hope. And hope, indeed, does not disappoint.

Give them courage and perseverance in their studies. May the Holy Spirit lighten their struggles until they know the joy of being a priest.


We ask this through Christ your Son. Amen.

When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at the knees of Jesus and said, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man."


For astonishment at the catch of fish they had made seized him and all those with him, and likewise James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners of Simon.


