



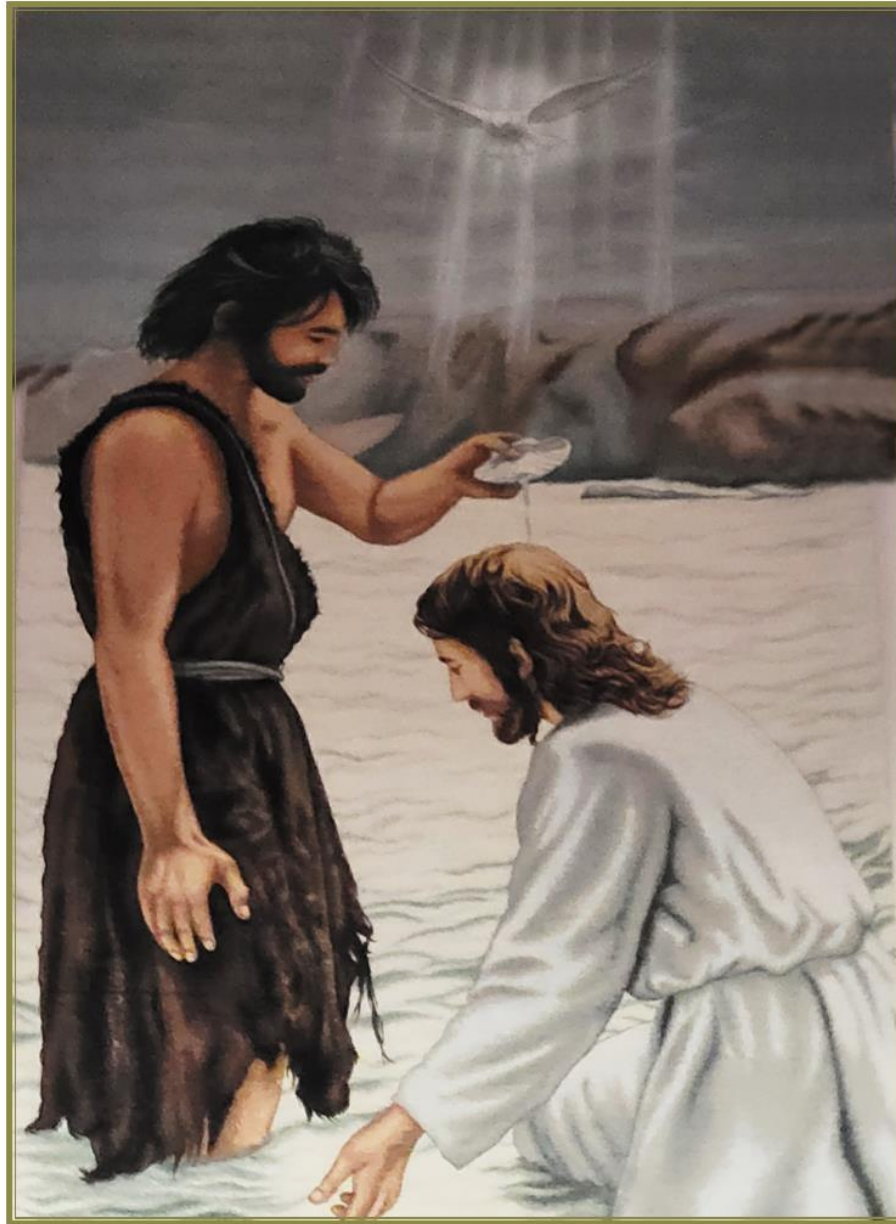

**Here are some tips when in snowy & icy weather**

- \* Take small steps—walk like a penguin!
- \* Take your time and avoid distractions
- \* Be alert on stairs and ramps; always use handrails.

- \* Use 3 points of contact entering/exiting vehicles  
Use 2 hands and 1 foot; or 2 feet and 1 hand.
- \* Wear boots or slip resistant soles.
