This past week, Rose Wertz, Shelly Palumbo, Connie and Ruben Roman, and I attended the annual Diocesan Convocation held at St. Joseph’s parish and the Grand Junction Convention Center.

This year the presenters Lucas Pollice and Msgr. Jorge de los Santos spoke on the importance of the Eucharist and the importance of the Mass in our life.

In addition to Mass, one of the most moving experiences for me was Eucharistic Adoration. After each Mass we remained in the church for the evening’s talk and following the talk we had adoration for about forty-five minutes to an hour. During that time, we sang songs of adoration, prayed for our parishes, and experienced good discernment by our Eucharistic Revival teams. In addition to Eucharistic Adoration, before each after-lunch session we prayed the rosary or the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.

Thank you very much for all your prayers. Throughout the week, our parish Eucharistic Revival team had some great prayer experiences, enriching small group discussions, and was inspired by wonderful testimonies. Having returned, I am excited to see how the Holy Spirit continues to call us as a parish into a deeper relationship with Jesus.

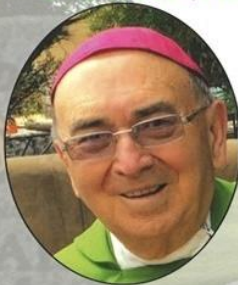

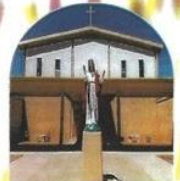
