

Guidelines for Fasting and Abstinence from the USCCB

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Fasting - Catholics aged 18-59 years are obliged to fast from food on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Abstinence - Catholics from age 14 onwards are called to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays during Lent, and Good Friday.









Mass 101 You are invited to experience


