

Guidelines for Fasting & Abstinence from the USCCB

Fasting—Catholics aged 18-59 years are obliged to fast from food on **Good Friday**.

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Abstinence— Catholics from age 14 onwards are called to abstain from meat on <u>Good Friday</u> and all Fridays during Lent.

As we approach Holy Week, PLEASE NOTE: Eucharistic Adoration will conclude April 16th at 6pm and will resume April 22nd at 7:30am FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT APRIL 6, 2025



Please join in praying for Bishop Berg and the dergy of our diocese as they participate in a Chrism Day of









